Dear Chief Executive,

I am writing to you in connection with the draft Ministerial Direction of 30 March 2015. I have now considered the report and recommendation prepared by you pursuant to s.31 of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended.

I have also considered the written submissions and observations received on the notice of intent to issue a Ministerial Direction in relation to the Adare Local Area Plan 2015-2021.

Having considered the said report and recommendations I have decided (i) that no material amendment to the draft direction of March 2015 is required, and (ii) that further investigation is not necessary in order to clarify any aspect of the report or submissions.

TAKE NOTICE that on 28th day of May, 2015 I have issued a Direction pursuant to Section 31 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended). A copy of this Direction is attached to this letter.



STEPS TO BE TAKEN


In light of the foregoing the Planning Authority is required, pursuant to Section 31(2) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) to comply with this Direction.

The Planning Authority should also publish notice of the making of the Direction and alteration to the Plan, and post a copy of such notice on its website.
