■ The Annual Report for the year 2004 sets out in the following pages the main activities and achievements of Limerick City Council during the year.

The process of change in the City Council which started under Better Local Government continued in 2004 with the election of a new Council. I look forward to working closely over the next five years with the Council and welcome our new Councillors and congratulate those who were re-elected.

The city faces significant challenges but will be presented with great opportunities during the life time of this Council. These major issues are set out in our new Corporate Plan which contains our agreed mission, objectives and strategies.


The City Council will continue to foster community and economic development by working closely with community groups, statutory agencies and business interests who have the well being and growth of the city as their focus.

I am pleased with the continuing high level of investment by the private sector in the city which continues to be matched with major public investment in infrastructure, particularly in water, wastewater, broadband services and roads, as is evident by the near completion of the main drainage project.

The Council has over 3000 housing units under its management and made significant additions to its stock in 2004. At the important northern entrance to the city the N7 Parkway Road Re-alignment at the Groody Bridge was completed thus removing a serious traffic bottleneck.

The physical renaissance of Limerick is apparent to all and the city is widely acknowledged as a leader in urban renewal and is internationally recognised for this. I wish to place on record my appreciation to all concerned who contribute to the advancement of development, from both the private and public sectors.

I would like to acknowledge and express my appreciation for the loyalty and dedication of staff for our many achievements in 2004. I also wish to express my thanks to the Mayor Cllr. Michael Hourigan and his immediate predecessor, Cllr. Dick Sadlier, together with the members of Council for their enthusiasm, support, ideas and assistance over the year.

- Leagann an Tuarascáil Bhliantúil don bhliain 2004 amach sna leathanaigh seo a leanas na príomh-ghníomhaíochtaí agus na príomh-éachtaí de chuid Chomhairle Cathrach Luimnigh i rith na bliana.

Leanadh ar aghaidh leis an bpróiseas athraithe sa Chomhairle Cathrach sa bhliain 2004 le toghadh Chomhairle úire, próiseas a thosaigh faoi Rialtas Áitiúil Níos Fearr. Táimse ag tnúth lena bheith ag obair go dlúth in imeacht na gcéad chúig bliana eile leis an gComhairle agus fearaimse fáilte roimhe ár gComhairleoirí nua agus guimse comhghairdeas orthu siúd a atoghadh. Tá dúshlán nach beag os comhair na cathrach, ach is amhlaidh a chuirfear deiseanna iontacha os a comhair le linn bheatha na comhairle seo. Leagtar amach na mórcheistean sin inár bPlean Corparáideach úr ina bhfaightear ár misean, cuspóirí agus straitéisí comhaontaithe. Leanfaidh Comhairle na Cathrach ar aghaidh ag cothú fhorbairt an phobail agus an gheilleagair tríd an dlúth-obair le grúpaí pobail, gníomhaireachtaí reachtúla agus leasanna gnó a mbíonn leas agus fás na cathrach mar a bhfócas acu.

Is cúis áthais dom an t-ardleibhéal leanúnach infheistíochta ag an earnáil phríobháideach sa chathair, agus infheistíocht mhór phoiblí um bonneagar leis, go háirithe san uisce, dramhuisce, seirbhísí leathanbhanda agus bóithre, mar is léir ó leath-chomhlíonadh an phríomh-thionscadail draenála. Tá os cionn 3000 aonad titheochta ag an gComhairle faoina bainistíocht, agus breiseáin mhóra tógtha aice dá stoc sa bhliain 2004. Críochnaíodh Athailíniú Bóthair Parkway an N7 ag an mbealach isteach aduaidh chuig an gcathair ag Droichead Groody, agus tranglam géar tráchta á bhaint dá bharr.

Is léir athfhorbairt fhisiciúil Luimnigh do chách, agus aithnítear an chathair go forleathan mar cheannaire um athnuachan uirbeach agus is go hidimáisiúnta a aithnítear sin leis. Ba mhian liom mo bhuíochas a thaifeadadh do gach duine lena mbaineann, dream a rannchuireann le cur chun cinn na forbartha, ó idir na hearnálacha príobháideacha agus poiblí araon.

Ba mhaith liom mo bhuíochas a chur in iúl agus aitheantas a thabhairt d'fhoireann as a ndílseacht agus a ndúthracht dár il-éachtaí sa bhliain 2004. Ba mhian liom mo bhuíochas a rá freisin leis an Méara an Cmlr. Michael Hourigan agus a réamhtheachtaí díreach, an Cmlr. Dick Sadlier, in éineacht le baill na Comhairle as ucht a gcuid díograise, tacaíochta, smaointe agus cúnaimh i gcaitheamhna bliana.

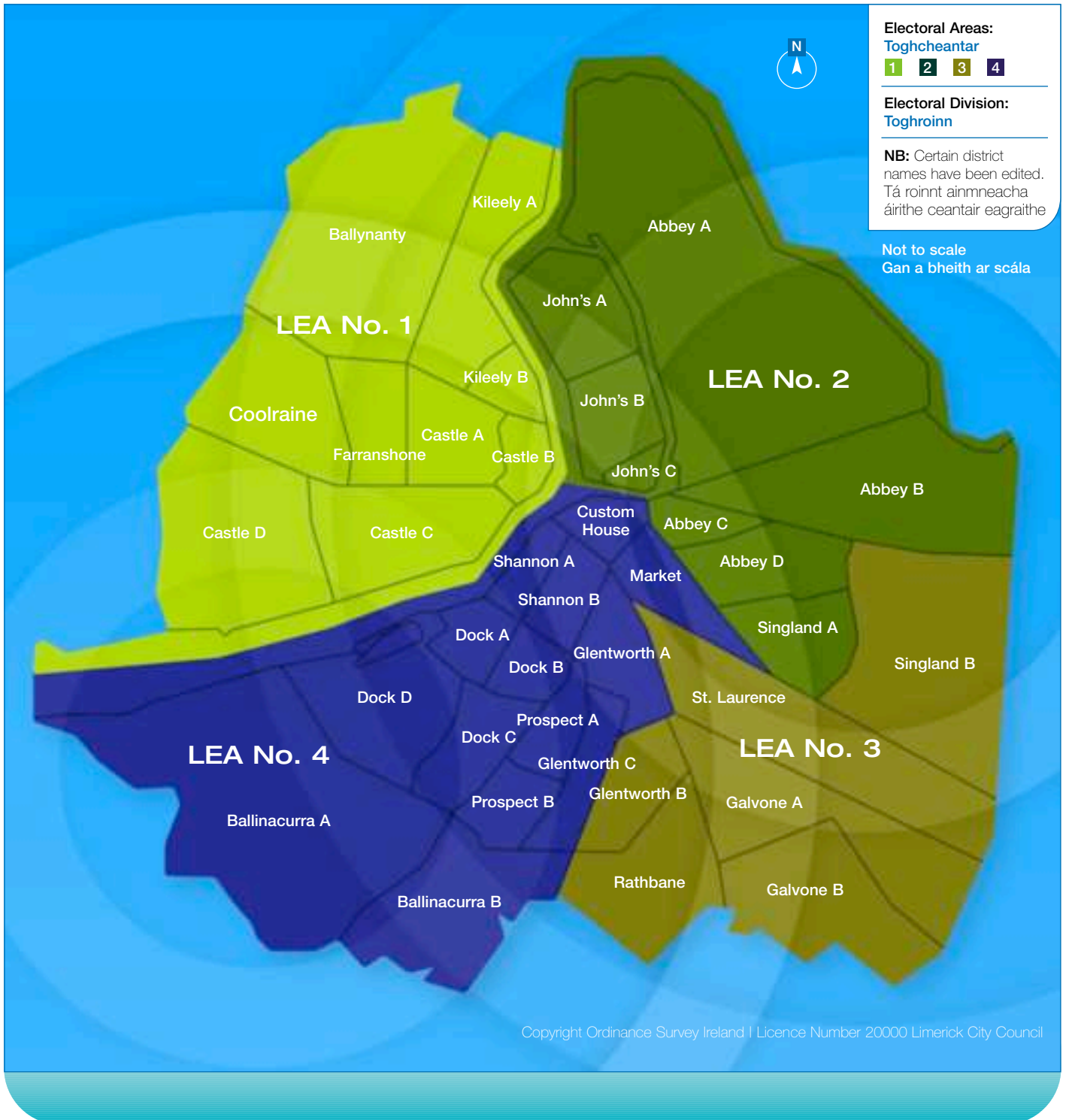

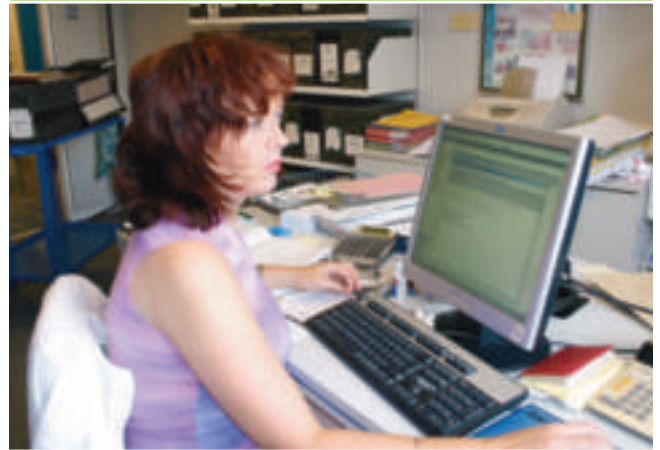
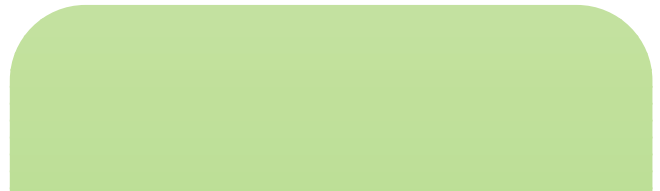

## Sanitary Services

### Waste Water & Sewage

The Limerick Main Drainage Project is a major environmental and infrastructural project that will enable Limerick City and its environs to provide for the domestic, industrial and commercial development of the area well into the new millennium and will lead to improvements in water quality in the River Shannon. The scheme comprises of a new wastewater treatment plant at Bunlicky, a main lift pump station at Corcanree together with some 45km of large diameter interceptor sewers. This new wastewater infrastructure has been constructed to meet the requirements of the EU Directive on Urban Waste Water Treatment and to ensure compliance with the Shannon Estuary Water Quality Management Plan.

The new Waste Water Treatment Plant was officially opened by the Minister for the Environment, Heritage & Local Government, Martin Cullen TD, on Friday 21st May. The Plant has a design capacity of 130,000 population equivalents. The plant also includes a sludge treatment installation, which provides for the treatment of wastewater sludge's generated both in the Waste Water Treatment Plant and the surrounding region and the production of bio-solids for beneficial re-use. The complete treatment process is automated and controlled using computer software to continually monitor operating plant status and process quality.

*"The project involves the elimination of some 50 sewer outfalls which had been discharging directly to the Shannon and Abbey Rivers. Now Limerick and its surrounding area will be fully compliant with EU directives on urban waste water treatment and will meet international quality standards", said Minister Cullen.*

The Limerick Main Drainage Project, which has involved carrying out of 19 major engineering contracts over the last four years, has been promoted by Limerick City Council as the lead authority in association with Limerick and Clare County Councils. Funding for the project was provided by the Department of the Environment, Heritage & Local Government under the National Development Plan and by the E.U. Cohesion Fund.

### Water

The European Communities Drinking Water Regulations, 2000. (S.I. 439 of 2000) and Directive 98/83/EC came into effect on the 1st January 2004. These new regulations have increased the amount of monitoring and the number of testing parameters for drinking water.

### Main Achievements

Limerick City Council produced in excess of 18.5 million cubic meters of potable drinking water in 2004

- 99.2% compliance with EU Drinking Water Regulations 2004  
Amongst the highest compliance rates in the country.
- 100% compliance rate with Microbiological Parameters in 2004

The Limerick City Water Conservation project made more progress during 2004 and has succeeded in further reducing unaccounted for water levels in the city by an average of 1500m<sup>3</sup> day.

Considerable progress on control of the system was also made during the year installing new flow meters and Telemetry on the distribution system. In excess of 2000m of old watermain was replaced during 2004 and new water connections were provided for 65 major new developments in the City.

Limerick's City's Fire and Rescue Services are engaged in duties in an area of approximately 419 sq. kilometres which holds a population in excess of 100,000 people including its Borough and adjoining areas in counties Limerick and Clare. It also provides a fast and effective response to road traffic accidents, flooding and other emergencies.

### Fire & Rescue Achievements

- Attended 1494 fires

This years theme was 'War' with keynote lecture given by Fatima Gailani. Speakers included Ciaran Carson, Hugo Hamilton, Lara Marlowe, Avi Shlaim, Derek Summerfield and Ivan Bacik.

#### Day of Welcomes May 1st

As part of the cultural programme of the EU Presidency, the "Day of Welcomes" was at the heart of a national weekend of celebration showcasing the generosity and spirit of Ireland to our new E.U. neighbours. Limerick, linked with Slovenia, held an extensive programme of events, including concerts at King John's Castle by both Limerick and Slovenian groups. Limerick's street theatre Company, The Umbrella Project with the Slovenian Street Theatre Company, Serpentes, presented a spectacular street event, full of colour and sound.

#### Cuisle International Poetry Festival

Cuisle took place in various city centre venues from 11th to 16th October and involved readings, workshops, book launches and exhibitions. Participants enjoyed readings by leading poets Paul Durcan, Michael D. Higgins, Ian Duigh, Simon Armitage, John

O'Donoghue, Trevor Joyce, Desmond O'Grady, Knute Skinner, Kevin Higgins and Nuala Ni Chonchúir along with first time published poets Imelda Maguire, Nigel Mc Laughlin, Maureen McAteer and Leanne O'Sullivan. The launch of a first novel "Limerick Junction" by Limerick writer Liam Liddy took place along with the third Story Thursday Book of the new millennium. The Limerick City Council Arts Office, in association with the WhiteHousePoets, hosted a Poetry Workshop, that continued as a series of workshops after the festival. The Workshops were facilitated by Galway poet Kevin Higgins and over the six week period various aspects of poetry were covered, including how to craft a poem, subject, style and metre were examined.

#### Sionna Festival of Traditional Music and Dance

This year the festival took place from 8th to 28th November culminating in the TG4 Gradam Ceoil Awards live at UCH on the 28th. The festival included a workshop by The Shanghai Percussion Ensemble from China, performances from Radio Tarifa from Spain, and Sabreen from Palestine, a performance of The Goldberg Variations at St. Mary's Cathedral, and The Turner Trio at The Georgian House & Gardens.

Part of the outreach element of the festival was the street performance of Squeal Amach 2 : The Butcher's Revenge. This street event built on the success of last year's event, retaining the same basic format but adding a few new elements. The music was composed by Mícheal Ó Súilleabháin and scripted by Mike Finn. The event was produced and directed by The Umbrella Project.

## Public Access and Participation

### Story Making on Film

#### - The Banshee Lives in the Handball Alley

A collection of stories on DVD from St Munchin's Boys NS and St Mary's NS, was produced as part of an Artist in Residence in Schools Scheme.

The Banshee Lives in the Handball Alley is an archival collection of stories, characters, sayings and superstitions as told by the fifth classes of St. Munchins and St. Mary's schools over a two week period in September. Facilitated by Michael Fortune and Aileen Lambert and co-ordinated by Limerick City Council the storymaking process uncovered stories which revealed a remarkable knowledge and wealth of folklore, ancient and contemporary, which were completed in the boundless imaginations of the storytellers themselves. Funded by the Arts Council of Ireland and Limerick City Council, copies of the dvd are available from The Arts Service, Limerick City Council.

### May Music in The Park

Limerick's own Boherbuoy Brass & Reed Band gave public performances on three Saturday's in May in the People's Park.

### Collaboration and Partnership

Compose Yourself in association with The Irish Chamber Orchestra Compose Yourself, a three-year area-based project (2002-04), took place in Limerick City South. Captured Moments, took place on December 13th/14th at the Limerick City Gallery of Art.

Up to 150 children in three primary schools took part in Compose Yourself a weeklong creative music workshops in their schools, leading to informal performances recorded on video.

The emphasis was on social and musical outcomes. Group work, experiential learning, development of musical skills, feedback and evaluation were key aspects of the programme. Art work derived from these videos are included in the composition/performance of new work which is based on the music devised by the children. The children involved in the workshops attended the rehearsal process of the new commission and were guests at the first public performance.

### Music Network

A performance by The Trio Turner (France) took place on Friday 26th November at The Georgian House & Gardens. Highlights include the trio's critically-acclaimed recording of the entire works of Arnold Bax for flute, viola and harp and its world première of Serge Nata's Commentaires Sentimentaux at the 8th World Harp Congress in Geneva. This performance was presented with kind assistance from the Embassy of France, Cultural Section, and AFAA.

### Jim Kemmy Municipal Museum

The museum's online catalogue at [limerickcity.ie](http://limerickcity.ie) was extensively expanded in 2004 and was officially launched by the Minister for Arts, Sport and Tourism, John O'Donoghue on 3 June. The average number of visitors to the catalogue per week has exceeded 10,000 and the total number of hits at the end of the year was 347,530.

There were 144 additions to the museum collection during the year. Most notable included: Limerick silver teaspoon by Thomas Walsh, c.1770; Limerick silver salt spoon by Maurice Fitzgerald, c.1800; a pocket watch by Sterling, Limerick, 1872; a button of Limerick Merchant Volunteers, c.1780; a poster of the Theatre Royal, 1857; a review of Limerick Skating Rink, Wellesley Place, 1909; newspaper, the New York Daily Tribune, 28 August 1848, with extensive reports on the Young Ireland insurrection and its aftermath; a medal of Limerick Motor Club, 1930s; a tin for Spillane's Two Flakes tobacco and a photograph of the tanks Scotch & Soda on Thomond Bridge, April 1919.

Visitor numbers, at 13,825, were consistent with 2003.

An exhibition of painted beehive panels from Slovenia was mounted to mark the enlargement of the European Union. The exhibition was officially opened by Mr. Anton Rop, Prime Minister of Slovenia.

### Guide for young people to the Permanent Collection

LCGA published a guide for young people to the Permanent Collection. This guide was designed to act as a stimulus for young people and their educators to study and discuss some of the wonderful work in the collection. It will cover a variety of items in the collection including paintings by Paul Henry, Sir William Orpen, Jack B Yeats, and John Shinnors. It will also discuss drawings from the National Collection of Contemporary Drawings and items of Sculpture, photography and Multi-Media. The guide was published with the help of a Heritage Council Grant.

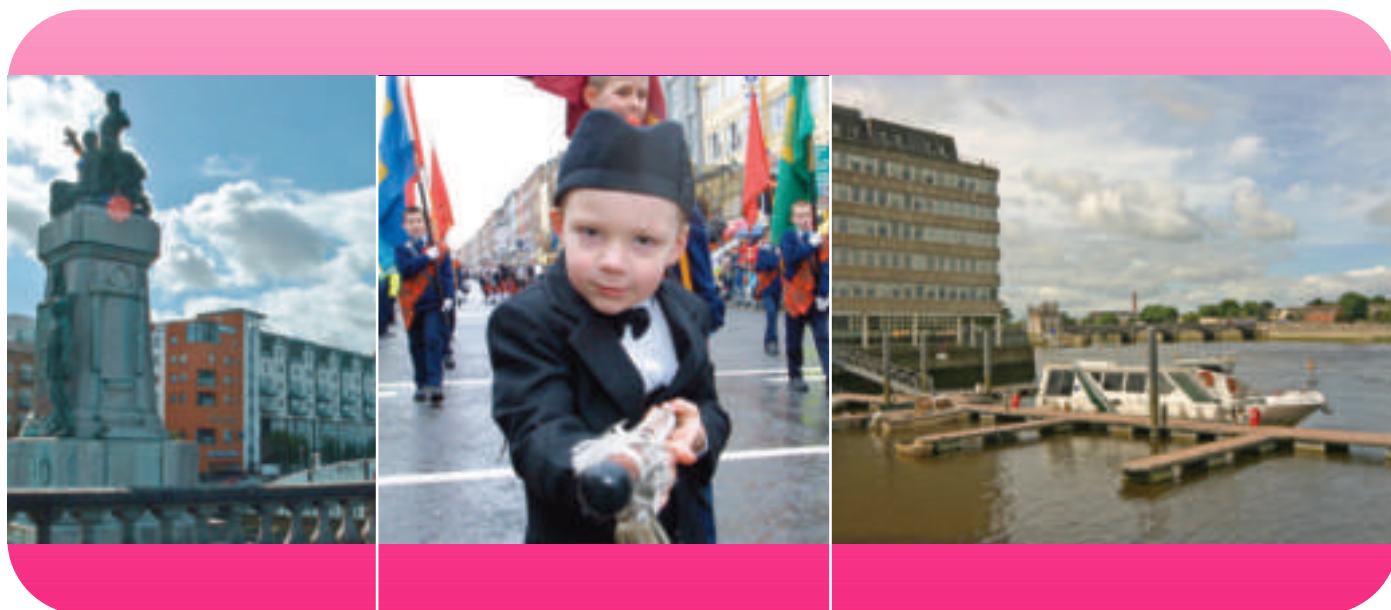


# Community & Enterprise - Leading the Process

## Pobal & Fiontar - An Próiseas a Cheannaireacht

**A co-ordinated & integrated approach to social, economic & cultural development**

**Cur chuige comhordaithe & comhtháite don fhorbairt shóisialta, eacnamúil & chultúrtha**



Seeking to achieve a co-ordinated and integrated approach to the social, economic and cultural development of Limerick City via the Limerick City Development Board and related programmes (RAPID, Childcare Committee, Community Forum, Social Inclusion Unit) and supporting Limerick City Council which is charged with leading the process.

### City Development Board

The year marked a highly successful conclusion to the City Development Board's application for funding measures to improve cohesion across local and community development structures. The proposal focussed on actions measuring the existing levels of cohesion in Limerick, supporting the development of specific community structures and premises, staffing needs to make community and voluntary structures more disability friendly, and specific actions to make Limerick a more equality friendly city.

Following an independent appraisal, the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government approved the payment of a total grant of €221,800 for the following purposes:

- Development of a web-based, interactive directory of social inclusion services
- Kileely Community Centre
- O'Malley Park Community Centre.

The process leading to the submission of the proposal in 2004 typified efforts in Limerick aimed at enhancing social inclusion service delivery through a co-ordinated approach, and reflects the close collaborative nature of the work between the City Development Board and partner organisations.

### Limerick: Profile of a Changing City

A socio-spatial profile of the city was compiled using the data from the small area population statistics taken from the 2002 Census. This in-depth report examines Limerick City and environs in a national and regional context and looks at the profound changes that Limerick has undergone in recent years. The City Development Board made formal contributions to key recommendations contained in the Regional Strategy and Regional Planning Guidelines for the Mid-West Region, and provided a detailed and comprehensive submission to inform the drafting of the Limerick City Development Plan. Following local elections in June 2004, a newly-constituted Board undertook a series of extensive deliberations on the political and technical case for a borough boundary extension in Limerick City. In line with government measures introduced in 2003 to tackle social exclusion by improving cohesion across local and community development structures, the members of the Board formally endorsed the annual work plans of nine local development agencies in Limerick City.

During the year the Reception and Integration Agency at the Department of Justice, Equality and Law Reform proposed that

Limerick City become a pilot area for exploring a co-ordinated response to an integration policy for refugees. The Board welcomed the proposal and agreed that a comprehensive survey would be undertaken.

With the assistance of students from the University of Limerick, desk research on models of 'Cities of Learning' and an initial survey of current educational provision was undertaken. Regular progress reports have been provided to the City Development Board and a series of presentations raising awareness of Limerick as a 'City of Learning' have been designed and given to a number of organisations and individuals. A programme of fundraising has commenced with €4000 raised to date. A baseline audit of learning provision in Limerick is now underway and a database will be compiled and available as a resource in 2005.

The annual Comhairle na nÓg was held in the exhibition area and the Council Chambers of City Hall in May. Over 40 young people aged between 12 to 18 years attended with the gender balance on the day at 59% female and 41% male.

A Youth Forum was also formed to develop further links which will allow the delegates represent their views at a broader local level on structures such as the City Development Board and Strategic Policy Committees. The Forum has also the responsibility of nominating delegates for Dáil na nÓg and any other event which will take place before the next Comhairle na nÓg in 2005

### Childcare Committee

The City Childcare Committee recruited a Development Worker and Administrator to support the existing co-ordinator. Throughout the year, the committee worked collaboratively with a number of key agencies to raise awareness, build capacity, disseminate information and produce childcare publications, support applicants to avail of the EOCP funding, set up a childcare database, and support childcare providers to avail of training and development opportunities.

### Limerick City Community Forum

The Community Forum substantiated its work of previous years and identified new areas of development such as blood drives and seminars on positive well-being. Through levels of representation on the City Development Board, various sub committees of the Board and Strategic Policy Committees issues of concern such as the lack of secondary school places and substance abuse across the city have been highlighted.

### RAPID Programme

The following three areas were specifically designated as RAPID areas in Limerick City, reflecting the high levels of social exclusion experienced by a number of communities in the city.

- Limerick City Centre: Kings Island and Watergate Flats.
- South Limerick City: Southill, Our Lady of Lourdes, Our Lady Queen of Peace, St Saviours
- North Limerick City: Kileely, Thomondgate, Ballynanty and Moyross

Since the launch of the RAPID Programme, 51 projects are currently being implemented across the city with 11 projects successful for Dormant Account funding and five projects successful for Sports Capital Funding. Structures were put in place to facilitate local area planning and development including the involvement of the local community into the decision-making processes. Recognition of areas in the strategic development of service plans has promoted cooperation and reduced competition between communities. The Dormant Accounts Programme was rolled out in 2004, and specifically targets RAPID, CLAR and Drugs Task Force areas for prioritisation. This fund assists a range of RAPID projects under the categories of Economic & Social Disadvantage, Educational Disadvantage and Persons with a Disability. Leverage funding has been allocated to the RAPID programme nationally to assist in the local delivery of RAPID Projects. Projects to be supported under capital funding in 2005 are identified through the local Area Implementation Team representatives and a number of these have been successful in Limerick, such as the Local Authority Estate Enhancement Scheme (LAEES) and Playground Scheme. The three RAPID areas have also been successful under the Sports Capital programme and Equal Opportunities Childcare Programme where in excess of €4 million was allocated to Limerick RAPID Projects.

### Social Inclusion Unit

Established in March 2002 to broaden the role of Limerick City Council in tackling social exclusion and poverty in Limerick City, the work of the SIU during the year included:

- Developing a guide to the housing of non-nationals
- Reviewing Limerick City Council's rental scheme to ensure it does not contribute to the creation of poverty traps
- Reviewing Limerick City Council's consultation policy
- Assisting the Housing Department in producing a literacy-friendly Tenants Handbook
- Translating information documents into French, Arabic and Russian
- Organising awareness raising events on issues such as literacy and interculturalism
- Providing policy guidance on social inclusion issues in relation to the development of the Sports and Recreation Strategy for Limerick

### Bord Forbartha na Cathrach

Ba chríoch fhíor-rathúil í an bhliain ar iarratas Bhord Forbartha na Cathrach do bhearta cistithe le comhtháthú ar fud na struchtúr forbartha áitiúil agus pobail a fheabhsú. Dhírigh an togra a aird ar ghníomhartha lena dtomhaisfí na leibhéil chomhtháthaithe atá ann i Luimneach, ar thacú le forbairt na struchtúr agus na n-áitreabh pobail faoi leith, na n-éileamh foirnithe le struchtúir phobail agus deonacha a dhéanamh níos fabhraí do mhíchumas, agus gníomhartha ar leith le Luimneach a chur ar bhonn níos fabhraí don chomhionannas mar chathair.

I ndiaidh na dtoghchán áitiúil

i Meitheamh na bliana 2004, b'amhlaidh a chuiaghad Bord nuabhunaithe i mbun sraithe de dhíospóireachtaí forleathana um an gcás polaitiúil agus teicniúil i bhfabhar shíneadh críche baile i gCathair Luimnigh. Ag cloí le bearta an rialtais a tugadh isteach sa bhliain 2003 chun dul i ngleic leis an eisiámh sóisialta tríd an gcomhtháthú a fheabhsú trasna na struchtúr forbartha áitiúil agus pobail, thacaigh baill an Bhoird go foirmiúil le pleananna oibre bliantúla de chuid naoi ngníomhaireacht áitiúla um fhorbairt i gCathair Luimnigh.

Mhol an Ghníomhaireacht Fáiltiúcháin agus Comhtháite ag an Roinn Dlí agus Cirt, Comhionannais agus Athchóirithe Dlí i rith na bliana go mbeadh Cathair Luimnigh mar cheantar píolótach um thaiscéaladh ar fhreagra comhordaithe um beartas comhtháite do theifigh. D'fháiltigh an Bord roimh an moladh agus d'aontaigh siad go rachfaí i mbun suirbhé cuimsitheach.

Reachtáladh Comhairle na nÓg bhliantúil san ionad taispeántais agus i Seomraí na Comhairle de chuid Halla na Cathrach sa Bhealtaine. D'fhreastail os cionn 40 duine óg idir 12 agus 18 mbliana déag d'aois uirthi, le cóimheá na n-inscní ar an lá ag 59% bainneann agus 41% fireann.

Bunaíodh Fóram Óige fosta le breis nasc a fhorbairt a ligfidh do na toscairí a dtuairimí a chur in iúl ag leibhéal áitiúil níos leithne um struchtúir ar nós Bhord Forbartha na Cathrach agus na gCoistí Beartais Straitéisigh. Tá an Fóram freagrach as ainmniú na dtoscairí freisin do

### Fóram Pobail Chathair Luimnigh

Thug an Fóram Pobail substaint dá shaothar ó na blianta roimhe sin, agus d'aithin sé limistéir úra um fhorbairt ar nós na bhfeachtas fola agus na seiminear um fholláine dhearfach. ### Grove Island Leisure Centre

The Grove Island Leisure Centre in Corbally was officially opened on Thursday, 3rd June, by Minister for Arts, Sports and Tourism, Mr John O' Donoghue. Limerick City Council and King's Island Developments Ltd equally own this new centre, developed at a cost of €12.3 million. €3.8 million of the cost was funded by way of a government grant under the Swimming Pools Programme. Facilities include a 25m 5 lane pool, kiddies pool, learner's pool, sports hall, gym, steam room, sauna and jacuzzi.

### Rathbane Golf Course

This municipal parkland course is built on 125 acres and is located within the city suburbs. The day to day operation of the golf course is managed by Mack Trading (International) Ltd on behalf of Limerick City Council.

A very successful junior golf programme was held for a second year at the course. Over 50 young people from various parts of the city took part.

### Parks Service

Hanging baskets were placed on a further three bridges in 2004; Shannon Bridge, Abbey Bridge and O'Dwyer Bridge bringing the total 'Bridges in Bloom' in Limerick City to seven.

The Parks Service mowed in the region of 300 acres of grass during the year, raised a substantial quantity of plants in the Mill Road Nursery for subsequent planting out and carried out tree planting and pruning throughout the city.

The Mayor, Cllr. Dick Sadlier, planted a hornbeam tree in the People's Park during National Tree Week in March, to commemorate the week and the Special Olympics, held in Ireland in 2003.

### Limerick Looking Good

2004 was the first year of our new environment competition, 'Limerick Looking Good', which had two main categories: Best Residential Area and Best City Street, and also incorporates the popular, Annual Residential Front Garden Competition. Shannon Development, Garden World & Shamrock, Limerick City Co-Ordination Office and the City Council supported the competition, which generated widespread interest across the city. The winners were announced at a very enjoyable award ceremony held at the Limerick City Gallery of Art last October.

### National 'City Neighbourhoods' Competition 2004

Limerick City was the proud winner of three awards in the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government's City Neighbourhoods Competition. Mr Batt O Keefe T.D., Minister of State, presented the awards at a ceremony in Dublin Castle, on 15th November.

Silver Brook, Mill Road, Corbally, was the national winner in the Best Residential Area Category. O' Connell Street won the award for Best Residential/ 'Mixed Use' Street. The People's Park was a special category winner in the Best Local Park award, which it also won in 2003.

This is the second year of the City Neighbourhoods Competition. Similar to the Tidy Towns Competition City Neighbourhoods is limited to areas within the city boundaries of Cork, Dublin, Galway, Limerick and Waterford.

### Cemeteries

The three cemeteries: Mount St. Lawrence, Mount St. Lawrence extension and Mount St. Oliver, were maintained to their usual high standard. Pathway improvement works were completed at Mount St. Lawrence.

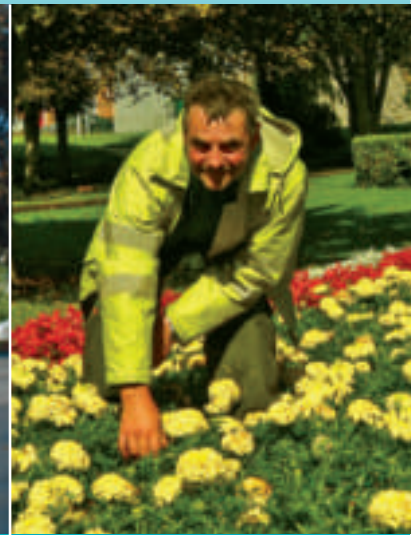
