**Extinguishment of Public Right of Way - Section 73, Roads Act 1993  
Cassidy's Lane to Sarsfield Court - Road no. L1081-1**

During the course of a Local Operational Briefing with the Councillors of the Limerick Metropolitan area on 6th December, 2016, a request was made to Finbarr Keyes, S.E.E. to initiate the process of closing off a public right of way at an alleyway known as Cassidy's Lane leading to Sarsfield Court in Garryowen.

Adverts were placed in the Limerick Leader and Limerick Post of 21st of January, indicating the Council's intention to extinguish the public right of way. Maps were made available at both Merchant's Quay and Dooradoyle offices for a period of one month from Monday 23rd January to Wednesday February 22nd, 2017. Signs were also placed at both entrances to the alleyway. Objections or representations were invited to be submitted prior to Wednesday 8th March, 2017. No submissions were received.

It is therefore proposed to proceed to extinguish the right of way at this location, and I request your approval to this course of action.
