- 8.** I will ask at the next Meeting if consideration could be given to the substitution of L1423, from the Seven Sisters Pub to Clorhane, for L1423, Curraghbridge towards Ballylongford, on the 2016 List of Local Road Schemes in circumstances where L1423 Curraghbridge towards Ballylongford was completed during the 2015 Roads Scheme.
