Dear Tina,

I refer to above and your correspondence of the 21st of May, 2015 relative to same, the content of which has been noted.

I too am disappointed greatly by the fact that the Bruff Garda District is once again devoid of a Superintendent following the transfer of Superintendent Pattwell from Bruff to Roxboro Road for purely operational reasons after only a very short period of time.

While I will do all in my powers to expedite the appointment of a replacement for Superintendent Pattwell, I am not in a position to specifically identify a timeframe as it will require the holding of a competition at National level and same has not yet been advertised.

However, in the meantime I have appointment Inspector Luke Conlon as Acting District Officer in the Bruff Garda District and Inspector Conlon will be able to conduct almost all of the duties & responsibilities of the Superintendent. Inspector Conlon is the senior Inspector within my Division and he has vast experience in dealings with all matters including a very important role as Garda Liaison on the Regeneration Committees in the North Side of the City.

Finally, should any issue arise that requires my intervention, I will have no hesitation in addressing same or attending your District Meetings either.

I trust this will allay some of the concerns raised by the meeting.
