TO: The Mayor and each Member of Limerick City and County Council

Re: Proposed Visit by Delegation to Hohenlohe, Germany, September 2016

The Landrat of Hohenlohekreis, Dr. Matthias Neth has invited a delegation from Limerick City and County Council to visit Hohenlohe in September.

The purpose of the visit is to strengthen the economic, social and cultural links between Hohenlohe and Limerick. Limerick County Council had been twinned with Hohenlohe for a period of 25 years prior to the amalgamation and the relationship has continued between Hohenlohekreis and Limerick City and County Council.

The Council is proposing to send a delegation of the Mayor of Limerick City and County Council and 6 Members to Hohenlohe in September 2016.

In accordance with Section 142(5) of the Local Government Act 2001, as amended, the approval of the Council is hereby sought for this proposed visit to Hohenlohe with an estimated cost of €742.17 per person.
