The Creative Ireland Programme CLÁR ÉIRE ILDÁNACH

The Creative Ireland Programme is the Government's Legacy Programme for Ireland 2016 – a five-year initiative, from 2017 to 2022, which places creativity at the centre of public policy. It is a high-level, high-ambition, all-of-government initiative to mainstream creativity in the life of the nation so that individually and collectively, in our personal lives and in our institutions, we can realise our full creative potential.

The Creative Ireland Programme is a culture-based programme designed to promote individual, community and national wellbeing. The core proposition is that participation in cultural activity drives personal and collective creativity, with significant implications for individual and societal wellbeing and achievement.

The Creative Ireland Programme is also the main implementation vehicle for the priorities identified in the Government's policy document, Culture 2025 - Éire Ildánach which states that arts and culture are intrinsic to the Irish State, acknowledges the need to increase access to, and participation in the arts, boost our creative industries, and preserve our heritage with a particular focus on language, landscape and the environment.

The programme is built around the themes of identity, culture and citizenship. The core operating principles are Collaboration and Communication, Community Empowerment, and Internationalisation.

Local authorities have a crucial role in the overall local delivery of the entire Creative Ireland Programme and are exclusively mandated, through their culture teams, to deliver Pillar 2 of the programme – Enabling Creativity in Every Community. This devolution of responsibility for Creative Ireland to local authorities is inspired by the extraordinary impact of collaborative local authority co-ordinated projects for the centenary of 1916.

Is Clár Leagáide an Rialtais é Éire Chruthaitheach d'Éire 2016 – tionscnamh cúig bliana, ó 2017 go dtí 2022, a chuireann cruthaitheacht i gcroílár an pholasaí poiblí. Is tionscnamh ardleibhéil, arduailmhéine, uile rialtais atá ann le cruthaitheacht a phríomhshruthú i saol an náisiúin i dtreo is gur féidir linn ár n-acmhainn iomlán cruthaitheach a bhaint amach inár saol pearsanta agus inár n-institiúidí, go hindibhidiúil agus i dteannta a chéile.

Is clár cultúr-bhunaithe é Éire Chruthaitheach a ceapadh le folláine indibhidiúil, pobail agus náisiúnta a chur chun cinn. Is í an tairiscint lárnach atá ann ná go ndéanann rannpháirtíocht i ngníomhaíocht chultúrtha cruthaitheach phearsanta agus chomhchoiteann a thiomáint, le himpleachtaí d'fholláine agus do mhórghníomhartha indibhidiúla agus sochaíoch.

Tá Éire Chruthaitheach ar an bpríomhmhodh iompair do na tosaíochtaí a aithnítear i gcáipéis polasaí an Rialtais, Cultúr 2025 - Éire Ildánach a luann gur dlúthchuid de Stát na hÉireann iad na healaíona agus an cultúr, aithnítear ann an gá chun méadú a dhéanamh ar rochtain agus ar rannpháirtíocht sna healaíona, ár dtionscail chruthaitheacha a neartú, agus ár n-oidhreacht a chaomhnú le fócas faoi leith ar theanga, ar thírhdreach agus ar an gcomhshaol.

Tá an clár tógtha mórthimpeall ar na téarmaí a bhaineann le féiniúlacht, cultúr agus saoránacht. Is iad na príomhphrionsabail oibriúcháin ná Comhoibriú agus Cumarsáid, Cumasú an Phobail, agus Idirnáisiúnú.

This Plan sets out the beginning of our part in this five-year journey, a truly important national policy initiative centred on culture and wellbeing.

The first public manifestation of Creative Ireland Programme in Limerick took place on Easter Monday as part of Cruinniú na Cásca. Walking Limerick - Luimneach ag Siúl, a programme of free guided walking tours was delivered in the city and county. This programme was created to explore our relationship to our environment, recognise the part we play in contributing to the balance of our ecological systems, and consider the complex relationship between identity, culture and the landscape. The day was designed and delivered in collaboration with local civic organisations and tour guides who are active and passionate about connecting citizens to the wealth of cultural and natural heritage of Limerick. Stimulated by the great public response, we will continue to work with individuals, groups and organisations to reach out and encourage everyone to be a part of our creative and cultural landscape.

Tá ról ríthábhachtach ag údaráis áitiúla maidir le soláthar foriomlán áitiúil an chláir iomlán Éire Chruthaitheach agus iad faoi shainordú eisiach, tríd a bhfoirne cultúrtha, Colún 2 den chlár a sholáthar – Cruthaitheacht a Chumasú i nGach Pobal. Tá dílárú na freagrachta seo maidir le hÉire Chruthaitheach chuig údaráis áitiúla spreagtha ag tionchar suaithinseach na dtionscadal comhordaithe go comhoibríoch ag údaráis áitiúla do chomóradh céad bliain 1916.

Leagann an Plean seo amach tús ár rannpháirtíochta sa turas cúig bliana seo, ar thionscnamh polasáí ríthábhachtach náisiúnta é dírithe ar chultúr agus ar fholláine.

Tharla an chéad léiriú poiblí ar Chlár Éire Chruthaitheach i Luimneach ar Luan Cásca mar chuid de Chruinniú na Cásca. Luimneach ag Siúl, clár de spaisteoireachta faoi threoir soar in aisce á soláthar sa chathair agus sa chontae. Ceapadh an clár seo d'fhonn breathnú ar gcaidreamh lenár dtimpeallacht, an pháirt atá againn maidir le cur le cothromaíocht ár gcóras éiceolaíoch a aithint, agus féachaint ar an ngaolmhaireacht chasta idir féiniúlacht, cultúr agus an tírdhreach. Déanadh an lá a cheapadh agus a chur i láthair i gcomhar le heagraíochtaí pobail áitiúla agus le treoraithe turais atá gníomhach agus paiseanta maidir le saoránaigh a nascadh le saibhreas oidhreachta cultúrtha agus nádúrtha Luimnigh. Le spreagadh faighte againn ó fhreagra iontach an phobail, táimid chun leanúint linn ag obair le daoine indibhidiúla, le grúpaí agus eagraíochtaí agus teagmháil a dhéanamh agus spreagadh a thabhairt do chách le bheith mar chuid dár dtírdhreach cruthaitheach agus cultúrtha.

To set out for a successful delivery of the ambitious five-year Creative Ireland Programme, in 2017 Limerick City and County Council will identify local projects which respond to Pillar 2 - *Enabling Creativity in Every Community* and determine gaps in current opportunities and services focused on the area of active engagement through culture and creativity. In these initial stages of implementation, we will build capacity around existing projects driven by access and engagement. We will also devise a support structure for development of new projects to meaningfully address the existing gaps.

The following pages introduce the Limerick Culture Team, which, in line with the requirements of Creative Ireland, consists of relevant personnel of Limerick City and County Council. This team will advise on the development of the Creative Ireland Programme in Limerick and via the Arts Office will provide administrative support for its implementation.

In Section 4 we inform about the channels through which we will communicate and interact with the public to ensure easy access to information about the developments and opportunities related to Creative Limerick, including open calls and public consultations. In the proceeding section the rationale driving the Creative Ireland 2017 Culture and Creativity Plan for Limerick City and County is set out alongside an initial selection of projects that will be supported in year one of the Creative Ireland Programme.

Le tabhairt faoi sholáthar rathúil ar an gclár uailmhianach cúig bliana Clár Éire Chruthaitheach, i 2017 aithneoidh Comhairle Cathrach agus Contae Luimnigh tionscadail áitiúla a fhreagraíonn do Chlár 2 – *Cumasú Cruthaitheachta i nGach Pobal* agus bearnaí a aimsiú sna deiseanna agus sna seirbhísí reatha atá dírithe ar rannpháirtíocht ghníomhach trí chultúr agus cruthaitheacht. Sna céimeanna tosaigh seo den chur i bhfeidhm, tógfaimid ar acmhainn na dtionscadal atá ann atá tiomáinte ag rochtain agus rannpháirtíocht agus ceapfar struchtúr tacaíochta le tionscadail nua a fhorbairt le haghaidh a thabhairt ar na bearnaí ar bhealach dáiríre.

Sna leathanaigh seo a leanas cuirtear i láthair Foireann Chultúir Luimnigh, ar a bhfuil, ag teacht le riachtanais Éire Chruthaitheach, pearsanra suntasacha Chomhairle Cathrach agus Contae Luimnigh. Tabharfaidh an fhoireann seo comhairle maidir le Clár Éire Chruthaitheach i Luimneach a fhorbairt agus soláthróidh sí tacaíocht riaracháin dá fhorfheidhmiú dtrí an Oifig Ealaíon.

Sna rannóga a leanas, leagtar amach an réasúnaíocht a bhaineann le Plean Gníomhaíochta Cultúir agus Cruthaitheachta na hÉireann 2017 do Chathair agus do Chontae Luimnigh agus na tionscadail a dtacófar leo sa chéad bhliain. Tá eolas freisin ann ar ár mbealaí cumarsáide agus idirghníomhaíochta lena chinntiú go mbíonn rochtain éasca ar eolas maidir forbairtí agus deiseanna a bhaineann le Luimneach Chruthaitheach, ar a n-áirítear gairmeacha oscailte agus comhairliúcháin phoiblí.

Cross-departmental and cross-organisational collaboration and community partnerships are key aspects of the Creative Ireland Programme. With that in mind, we will insure that throughout the process as many people as possible are informed and included in the implementation of the Creative Limerick 2017 Culture and Creativity Plan. We will also invite local communities and creative practitioners to contribute to the development of further stages of the Creative Ireland Programme. Below are some of the ways we will interact and communicate with our key audiences:

- Limerick City and County Council is relaunching the website Limerick.ie with over 800,000 people visiting the site each year. Creative Limerick will be present with its own page;
- We are social; Twitter, Facebook and e-newsletter platforms will be used for communication purposes;
- A series of cultural agora (from the Greek 'agorien' - to gather) will be organised to promote and create conversations around Creative Ireland;
- We will invite new projects through open calls;
- We will evaluate the needs of the sector in order to provide relevant professional development opportunities in the further stages of the Creative Ireland Programme implementation;

Is príomhghnéithe de Chlár Éire Chruthaitheach iad comhoibriú tras-rannach agus tras-eagraíochtúil agus comhpháirtíochtaí pobail. Agus sin ar intinn, déanfaimid deimhin de go gcuirtear an oiread daoine agus is féidir é ar an eolas le linn an phróisis agus go n-áirítear iad i gcur i bhfeidhm Phlean Gníomhaíochta 2017 do Luimneach Cruthaitheach. Táimid chun cuireadh a thabhairt freisin do phobail áitiúla agus do chleachtóirí cruthaitheacha cur le forbairt na gcéimeanna breise den Chlár Éire Chruthaitheach. Anseo thíos tá cuid de na bealaí ina ndéanfaimid idirghníomhú agus caidreamh lenár bpríomh-lucht spéise.

- Tá athsheoladh á dhéanamh ag Comhairle Cathrach agus Contae Luimnigh ar shuíomh gréasáin Limerick.ie le cuairt á thabhairt ag breis agus 800,000 duine ar an suíomh gach bliain. Beidh Luimneach Cruthaitheach i láthair lena leathanach féin;

- Beidh tionscadail nua á lorg againn trí ghairmeacha oscailte;
- Beidh measúnú á dhéanamh againn ar riachtanais na hearnála d'fhonn deiseanna ábhartha gairmiúla forbartha a sholáthar sna céimeanna breise d'fhorfheidhmiú Chlár Éire Chruthaitheach;

In the first year of the Creative Ireland Programme, LCCC Culture and Creativity Plan is driven by the Creative Ireland Programme Pillar 2 - Enabling Creativity in every Community and supports relevant objectives of Limerick Cultural Strategy 2016-2030. It aims to set the grounds for a successful implementation of the Creative Ireland Programme over the next five years. As such it works towards achieving the following, interrelated objectives:

1. Connecting citizens to existing creative opportunities and services;
2. Building capacity of relevant organisations, creative individuals and groups that work on development and/or delivery of cultural projects driven by citizen engagement;
3. Building capacity of relevant Local Authority bodies to foster and encourage creative activity in our city and county and to deliver creative programmes, particularly in underserved communities and areas of the city and county;
4. Identifying gaps in existing opportunities and services focused on citizen engagement through culture and creativity, and supporting development of projects that address these gaps.

The Limerick Culture and Creativity Plan is designed to build and strengthen the cultural work already underway across a number of departments in Limerick City and County Council. The projects identified for support are culture based projects that recognise the strength and interests that are unique to Limerick.

Sa chéad bhliain den Chlár Éire Chruthaitheach, tá Plean Cultúir agus Cruthaitheachta CCCL á thiomáint ag Colún 2 den Chlár Éire Chruthaitheach – Cumasú Cruthaitheachta i ngach Pobal agus tacú le cuspóirí ábhartha Straitéis Chultúrtha Luimnigh 2016-2030. Tá sé mar aidhm aige bonn a leagadh síos d'fhorfheidhmiú rathúil an Chláir Éire Chruthaitheach sna cúig bliana atá romhainn. Dá réir sin oibríonn sé i dtreo na gcuspóirí idirghaolmhara seo a leanas a bhaint amach:

1. Saoránaigh a chur i dteagmháil leis na deiseanna agus seirbhísí cruthaitheacha atá ar fail
2. Acmhainn na n-eagraíochtaí ábhartha, na ndaoine agus na ngrúpaí cruthaitheacha a oibríonn ar fhorbairt agus/nó soláthar na dtionscadal cultúrtha tiomáinte ag rannpháirtíocht na saoránach a thógáil;
3. Tógáil ar acmhainn chómhlachtaí na nÚdarás Áitiúil ábhartha le gníomhaíocht chruthaitheach a chothú agus a spreagadh inár gcathair agus ár gcontae agus le clár chruthaitheacha a sholáthar, go háirithe i bpobail agus i gceantair sa chathair agus sa chontae nach bhfuil freastal ceart á dhéanamh orthu;
4. Bearnaí a aimsiú sna deiseanna agus sna seirbhísí atá ann dírithe ar rannpháirtíocht na saoránach trí chultúr agus trí chruthaitheacht, agus tacú le tionscadail a fhorbairt a thugann aghaidh ar na bearnaí sin.

Ceapadh Plean Cultúir agus Cruthaitheachta Luimnigh le tógáil agus neartú a dhéanamh ar an obair chultúrtha atá ar siúl cheana féin i rannóga éagsúla de Chomhairle Cathrach agus Contae Luimnigh. Tá na tionscadail a aithníodh le tacaíocht a thabhairt dóibh bunaithe

The first step towards this goal was taken when preparing Limerick's Criunniú na Cásca, where existing guided walking tours related to cultural and natural heritage, celebrating the urban and the rural, were delivered as a structured programme and promoted under the Walking Limerick - Luimneach ag Siúl successfully engaging over a thousand citizens.

The Limerick Culture and Creativity plan will be achieved by supporting organisations, creative individuals and groups with financial grants administered through an open call and through recommendations received from the Grants under the Arts Act (GUA) panel. We will also provide increased financial support for established creative organisations with a proven track record of excellence to deliver projects in local communities in the city and county. In addition we will evaluate the needs of the sector in order to provide relevant professional development opportunities in the further stages of the Creative Ireland Programme implementation. The open call for projects will be announced in May 2017 and assessed by an independent expert panel.

We have been working towards increased cross-departmental collaboration and financial support provided to relevant Local Authority departments in Limerick through the Creative Ireland Programme. An internal call was announced within the Limerick City and County Council for projects that are in line with Pillar 2 of the Creative Ireland Programme and are currently delivered or are planned to be delivered over the next year. The following sections of Limerick City and County Council were invited to put forward their projects: Archives, Archaeology, Arts Office, Environment, Heritage, Innovate Limerick, Library Services, Limerick City Gallery of Art, Museum, Social Development, Planning, Public Interest and Economic Development, and Tourism. A number of projects submitted through this call will be supported as part of Limerick's 2017 Culture and Creativity Plan.

We will undertake a cross-departmental and cross-organisational assessment of creative projects rooted in citizen engagement. The gaps will be identified by evaluating the projects that were included in the 2017 Creative Limerick Culture and Creativity Plan drawing from the open call, the internal call and the recommendations from the 2017 GUA panel. These projects will be mapped in terms of the communities involved, geographic locations and forms of creative expression.

As part of the further stages of Creative Ireland Programme implementation, a new pilot programme, Engage Culture - Creative Ideas Incubator, will be rolled out by Limerick Arts Office. This programme will provide a support structure for development of well-informed projects with a solid implementation plans with a view to address the gaps identified in existing opportunities and services.

In 2017 through the Creative Ireland Programme, Limerick City and County Council has agreed to support projects in diverse communities, geographic locations and covering a wide range of art forms. Projects are divided into two categories: existing projects that will be deepened by providing an increased support, and projects/activities that will help to provide Limerick's communities with a greater access to cultural activities. The list presented below will be complimented by projects selected through an open call, which will be announced in May 2017.
