RE: Parnell Street, Davis Street and Wickham Street – Proposed revisions to Part VIII Drawing

Further to the workshop on the 9th November 2015 on the submissions received for the Part VIII proposals for Parnell Street, Davis Street and Wickham Street, and subsequent consultations, we attach a drawing showing potential revisions to the Part VIII drawing as originally issued. This drawing reflects the considered outcome of the workshop and subsequent consultations.

- Davis Street has reverted to 2-way traffic by the provision of a shared street for cars and cyclists
- Disabled parking has been relocated further along Parnell Street
- A loading bay has been provided outside 44/46 Parnell Street
- The bus stop has been relocated further along Parnell Street
- A loading bay has been located outside Joe McKenna's premises
- A looped access road has been provided for the traders in Hyde Park with additional parking and loading bay provided
- The scheme has been extended to include upgrade works to Upper Gerald Griffin Street.
- The cycle lane on the northern side of Parnell Street between Davis Street and Roches Street has been removed
- The footpath along northern side of Parnell Street between Davis Street and Roches Street has been widened
- The loading bay has been extended on the southern side of Parnell Street
- The disabled parking space on the southern side of Parnell Street has been relocated further along the street
- The corner geometry on the Mallow Street/Parnell Street junction has been modified to improve access to the loading bay on the northern side of Parnell Street.
- Additional parking has been provided in Russell Park
- Extent of scheme onto Roches Street has been curtailed

The Travel & Transport Directorate wish to thank you for your comments in relation to the submissions received for the project and look forward to your approval of the Part 8 for the much needed upgrade works to Parnell Street, Davis Street and Wickham Street.
