Reply

The Council developed a programme of works to facilitate the extension of Caherconlish cemetery, and has commenced work on site. The Council also provided a budget to undertake these works.

However, as the development of the extension progressed, it became apparent that additional works, over and above those initially identified, were necessary to ensure that the extension was developed to the highest possible standard. The additional necessary

works have now been identified and it is the intention of the Council to seek a costing for the additional works.

The Council is not in a position to definitively confirm at this point when the works will be totally completed until such time as the costing is received, funding secured and a timeframe for the carrying out of the works agreed.

The Council will keep the members informed of the likely completion date as soon as it is in a position to do so.
