REPLY:

A bin service was provided to the above mentioned cemetery however the service had to be removed due to misuse. Currently a number of TÚS workers are carrying out clean ups in both of the cemeteries in Athea and this is working well.

The Council provides a bin collection service to 11 cemeteries within the Newcastle West Municipal District in 2016 and this would have been budgeted for in this year's budget. Therefore the funding available for 2016 does not allow for the addition of any further bin collections for cemeteries. The matter can be revisited for 2017 should funding allow.
