I will move at the next meeting that regular inspections are carried out of gullies, culverts, pipes and watercourses to determine that they are fit for purpose and in working order throughout the year.

REPLY:

Manpower resources are not available to carry out regular inspections throughout the year on drainage infrastructure. Landowners are responsible for the maintenance of drainage infrastructure on their own properties under the Roads Act 1993 as amended. Limerick City and County Council responds to reports of blocked pipes usually by employing a specialised drainage contractor to free them. Ongoing maintenance of roadside inlets/gullies continues to be carried out, with a special emphasis during November following the shedding of leaves.
