REPLY

The Council will undertake a traffic study in this area to ascertain traffic speeds in order to assess the need for the provision of speed ramps in the Chill Chaoide Housing Estate, Clarina.

It should be noted that a list of agreed estates are currently being provided with traffic calming from the 2015 Budget. A programme for 2016 will be prepared later this year and this will be progressed in 2016 subject to funding. It should also be noted that the Council intends to introduce 30kph speed limits to Housing Estates throughout the City and County in 2016 with the 30kph Speed Limit being introduced to 30 estates in 2015.


