The next step regarding the proposals for a gasification plant will be for Cadence Enviropower Ltd to commence the statutory planning process with An Bord Pleanála and in particular to submit sufficient details to them to determine whether this proposal qualifies as Strategic Infrastructure Development. In parallel they will also have to submit an application for a waste licence to the Environmental Protection Agency. Cadence Enviropower Ltd have indicated that they intend to commence these processes in the coming months.
