REPLY

The consideration of feasible options by the appointed Engineering Consultants, Kilgallen & Partners, is at an early stage for the O'Rourke's Cross project. The initial traffic survey was conducted in mid-September to enable the typical month to be used as a basis for the design work. A traffic model has been developed and is being used as the basis for a consideration of the feasible solutions from the respective perspectives of safety, engineering buildability and impact on the environment. It is expected that by Spring 2016 the preferred option shall have been proposed by the engineering consultants. Following this, the Part VIII documentation, together with the Compulsory Purchase Order documentation, (if necessary), can be prepared.
