b) The proposal for traffic calming, footpaths and road markings from Daltons Cross has previously been submitted to Transport Infrastructure Ireland. The Council will pursue this proposal with Transport Infrastructure Ireland.

I will ask at the next Meeting if funding can be provided at Reilig Ide Naofa Cemetery, Abbeyfeale, for boundary fence adjoining Kelly's Old School.  
I will also ask for an update on the provision of a new Graveyard in Abbeyfeale.

**REPLY:**

In relation to fence adjoining Kelly's Old School and other works required at Reilig Ide Naofa Cemetery, quotations are being sought to complete all works subject to funding.

- Repair existing Concrete Post and Chain link fence within the cemetery.
- On the direction of the HSE, close off the existing illegal public access from the cemetery to a polluted drinking water spring located in adjacent private lands. In addition erect signage advising members of the public regarding the status of the polluted drinking water source.
- Disconnect the existing public lighting connection from the adjacent Kelly's Old School to the cemetery, make a new connection to public lighting including the instillation of micro pillars and make the public lighting safer in the cemetery, also possibly reducing the number of existing flood lights.
- Remove some of existing trees in the cemetery.

**The provision of a New Burial Ground in Abbeyfeale**

Over the last number of years several sites within easy access of Abbeyfeale town have been assessed, unfortunately due to poor ground conditions they all have been deemed unsuitable for use as a burial ground.

A desktop study was conducted late last year; another possible suitable site was identified near Knockbrack. The landowner was contacted regarding the Council seeking approval to carry out a site assessment on his lands. Unfortunately the land owner in question recently contacted the Council explaining that he does not wish to allow the Council conduct a site assessment on his lands or is he interested in disposing of the land.

The Council is seeking other alternative sites for a new cemetery in Abbeyfeale.
