Notice of Motion submitted by Councillor Paul Keller

I will move at the next meeting that the Limerick Regeneration programme cease the demolition of void domestic Council dwellings, other than those which are a safety issue. I propose that the funding for demolition of domestic dwellings, be reallocated instead, to building urgently required Social Housing.

Response:

The demolition and retention strategy being implemented in the four regeneration areas of Limerick city is in accordance with the Limerick Regeneration Framework Implementation Plan (LRFIP) adopted by the elected members of Limerick City Council in February 2014. This plan significantly reduced the extent of demolition proposed in the 2008 Regeneration Masterplan. In line with the commitment in the LRFIP for monitoring and review of the programme, a review of the demolition and retention strategy took place in 2015. This review proposes further reduction in the overall number of houses to be demolished and will be presented to the Elected Members at the next meeting.
