To: The Mayor and Each Member of Limerick City and County Council

Following the huge success of last year's Team Limerick Clean-up, which secured widespread national and regional media coverage, Team Limerick Clean-up2 (TLC2) is set to take place again this year on Good Friday, 25th March 2016. The TLC website is open for registrations – www.teamlimerickcleanup.ie

Once again the TLC steering group made up of Limerick City and County Council, JP McManus Benevolent Fund, DMC Communications, Mr Binman along with media partners, (Live 95 fm and the Limerick Leader), will be encouraging volunteers of all ages to register and get involved in this year's campaign.

TLC2 will run along similar lines to the 2015 initiative:

- Registrations will be taken via the website or over the phone by customer services.
- Group leaders will be contacted by text alert
- Groups will be provided with clean up kits (gloves and bags, litter pickers and Best Practice Guidelines 2016). (note we are expecting groups to reuse litter pickers from last year and any TLC bags that maybe left over).
- Tea and Coffee supplies will be organised for those that would like.
- Groups must designate their own clean up areas and meet at a self selected meeting point on the 25th March 2016.
- Litter picking is 10.00 am - 13.00 am.
- Mr Binman collections from pre-designated collection points will begin from 11.00 am until the early Easter Saturday morning and beyond if necessary
- For health and safety reasons **no individual registrations** will be taken this year and each group will be asked to nominate a **Safety Marshall**.

- A control room will be based in County Hall Dooradoyle on Good Friday.
- **The Gardai, HSE, Fire Service have been briefed that the event is to take place again.**
- A series of Best Practise meetings have been scheduled, (see table below) to brief volunteers on health and safety aspects of the campaign.

In addition TLC2 will appeal to all fast food outlets, convenience stores and service stations across the city and county of Limerick to support TLC2 by organising their own clean up teams and encouraging their customers to dispose of waste responsibly and to get involved. Fast food outlets will be contacted directly and supplied with TLC2 promotional material for display. All retail outlets that support this initiative will be recognised as a 'TLC2 Supporter'.
