Re: **Cappamore Langonnet Twinning Project**

A Chomhairleoir, a Chara,

Cappamore and Langonnet (France) signed a friendship agreement in 2010 following a number of visits by various delegations to both locations. They signed an official Twinning Agreement in 2011. Both communities share a desire of enhancing mutual understanding, unity and friendship between the Breton and Irish people.

Cappamore Twinning Committee have not received previous funding from the Council. A delegation from Langonnet visited Cappamore in April 2015 and they were hosted by families in Cappamore. Cappamore are now seeking a contribution from the Council towards the cost of these twinning activities.

The total cost incurred by Cappamore for the various activities in the course of the Langonnet visit was €1651. It is recommended that the Council fund 50% of this expenditure.

Therefore the Council's approval for the provision of financial assistance in the amount of €826 towards the cost of this twinning initiative is required.
