



Ownership of the following properties is being exchanged through the Section 183 process to facilitate the demolition of strategic dwellings under the Regeneration programme. The property owners contacted Limerick City Councils Regeneration team, seeking relocation as part of the regeneration project and their properties have been selected having regard to the strategic aims of the Limerick Regeneration Framework Implementation Plan (LRFIP) as approved by the elected members.

It is the intention to bring the Section 183 Notices to Full Council for approval.

1. Disposal of 2 Wallers Well, Roxboro Road to Eileen Hayes, in consideration of ownership of 528 Castle Oaks, O'Malley Park, Southill, being transferred to Limerick City & County Council.
2. Disposal of 4 Wallers Well, Roxboro Road to Martin & Ann Marie O'Connor, in consideration of ownership of 29 Rose Court, Keyes Park, Southill, being transferred to Limerick City & County Council.
3. Disposal of 8 Wallers Well, Roxboro Road to John & Geraldine Moloney, in consideration of ownership of 8 Beechgrove Avenue, Ballinacurra Weston being transferred to Limerick City & County Council.
4. Disposal of 9 Wallers Well, Roxboro Road to Anthony O'Donoghue, in consideration of ownership of 354 Roseview Drive, O'Malley Park, Southill, being transferred to Limerick City & County Council.
