
Question submitted by Councillor Tom Neville

“I will ask at the next Meeting for the following: (a) In 2014, how much was collectively allocated for private housing adaptation grant, mobility grant, housing aid for the elderly; (b) how much was allocated to the Adaptation for Local Authority Housing; and (c) the timeline in which the grant allocations will be made for both private and local authority housing in 2015”.

REPLY:

- (a) The total amount allocated for private housing adaptation grant, mobility grant, housing aid for the elderly was €2,961,549 for 2014.
- (b) The total amount allocated for Adaptation of Local Authority Housing was €505,919.67 in 2014.
- (c) Limerick City and County Council has not been advised by the Department of Environment Community and Local Government of its allocation for funding under the above headings for 2015.


