








General Works 2017

- Provision of additional car parking near Glenroe Church, to be complete Nov 2017.







The photograph above shows the footpath construction located between the Community Centre at Cappamore and the Cappamore G.A.A grounds, 500m.

The cost of the scheme was €100,000 approx. and was funded through the General Municipal Allocation 2017, Small Towns & Villages 2016 and Clar scheme 2016, Restoration Improvement Grants and Own resources. This project involved landtake from 2 landowners, alteration of ESB network, provision of public lighting, 500m footpath construction, surface water drainage and surface dressing of road pavement. The scheme was completed in July 2017.

GENERAL MUNICIPAL ALLOCATION -Nicker School to Nicker Village works - €23,500



Photographs 1 & 2 show - completed works alongside the wall near the existing footpath outside the Parochial house and works at the surface water outfall alongside the property of William Harty.

The area in front of the wall was strengthened using unbound Cl804 and was double surface dressed. This surface is suitable for pedestrian and vehicular traffic

GENERAL MUNICIPAL ALLOCATION Nicker School to Nicker Village works - €23,500



Photos 3 & 4 - Shows the ongoing strengthening works in front of the wall at Nicker and completed works on 18th September 2017. The works completed at Nicker include surface water drainage, public lighting ducting, road reconstruction and double surface dressing. The placement of the public lighting poles is outstanding.

I propose the placement of a yellow line 1.5m from the wall which would represent a safe surface for pedestrians. This represents a shared surface that would require no further maintenance.

GMA - Pedestrian crossing - Murroe Village €30,000.

This scheme will be completed later in year. The pedestrian crossing will be placed during September /October near the entrance to the New Sports Facility. The location of the crossing will be agreed shortly with the local community council. The best location is near Crokers pub/ Credit Union, but agreements need to be finalised regarding planning issues for proposed developments nearby.

Housing Maintenance

Disabled Person Grants / Private House Grants


- The total allocation for Cappamore Kilmallock Council House Disabled Persons' Grants for 2017 is €106,145.
- 10 Jobs, including one small extension, totalling €63,145.73 have been approved, and are almost complete. Another 8 small bathroom adaptations will be completed by year end to a value of roughly €44,000.
- Allocations for Private House Grants are by Operational Areas.
- 32 grants have been approved so far in 2017. These have a value of €214,424.69.
- Spend to date of €214,424.69 is 43% of South allocation of €500,000.

Parks Pitches and Open Spaces



- Grass Cutting 12 hectares in Cappamore/Kilmallock Municipal District.
- Maintenance of Kilmallock Park, MUGAs and amenity areas.
- Lough Gur operated under maintenace contract. Very important amenity in the area.

€30k support to Lough Gur Development Association in 2017

In 2011 Lough Gur Development commenced a long term lease of the lakefront visitor centre from Limerick Council & in 2013 completed a full refurbishment of the exhibition and building.

Visitor numbers to the visitor centre reached a record high of 45,000 in 2015 with 135,000 accessing the lakefront.

•Actively supports and encourages the cultural life of the community through a programme of events and activities including book launches, writer visits, artist exhibitions etc.


•Promotes reading across all age groups and particularly children through class visits, weekly storytelling, treasure hunts etc.
