

RE: Capital Assistance Scheme 2017

To whom it may concern,

The Department of Housing, Planning, and Local Government has announced the availability of funding under the Capital Assistance Scheme (CAS) Programme 2017.

Capital funding is available for delivery through, either the construction or acquisition of housing accommodation to cater for the priority groups as below

- Homeless persons (including “care leavers” exiting state care on reaching the age of 18)
- Elderly
- People with a disability with a particular emphasis on moving people with a disability from congregated settings into community based living.

Limerick City and County Council requests submissions as follows:-

- New CAS construction and acquisition proposals specifically for the provision of accommodation to meet the needs of all the target groups under CAS as follows:-
- Acquisition proposals specifically for the provision of accommodation to support people with a disability to move from a congregated setting into community based living.
