I will ask at the next Meeting as to when the matter of possible exposed Asbestos backing the Aldi Car Park will be made safe.

REPLY:

The Sugar CRM Case reference is 303934.

A statutory Section 55 notice Under the Waste Management Act 1996 (as amended) was issued to the owner on the 5th July 2017. The notice required the owner to carry out a risk assessment and a refurbishment demolition survey including an assessment of any asbestos. It also required the removal of all wastes including asbestos sheeting from the **land** at Church Street, Newcastle West Co. Limerick to an appropriate licensed/ permitted facility and to submit all relevant documentation within **9 weeks** of the date of service of the notice.

The Section 55 Notice was signed for on the 6th July 2017. To date no correspondence has been received from the Owners regarding this notice. The timeframe expires this week. If the notice has still not been complied with then further action including Legal Proceedings may have to be initiated.
