In July the Report from the Culture and Arts Working Group was brought to Council with recommendations including the establishment of a Cultural Strategic Policy Committee.

In September a resolution was passed by Limerick City and County Council to adopt the draft amended SPC Scheme, to establish a Cultural Strategic Policy Committee.

The membership will have a total number of 28 broken down as follows:

- 16 Elected Members - Comh. S. Ó Ceallaigh has already been nominated as Chair of the SPC
- 8 sectoral interests nominees, some of which will be via the PPN
- 4 Culture and Arts sector nominees – to be filled by open call to Cultural & Arts Sector. A recommendation on nominees will be made by the Councillors on the new SPC and brought to full Council for approval.
