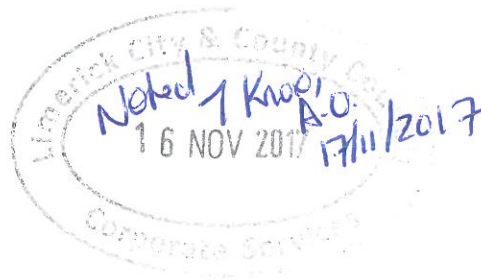

Dear Ms Knox,

I am in receipt of your correspondence of the 25th of October 2017 in the above, the content of which is noted.

I am not in a position to confirm when the Superintendents position for the Bruff District will be filled on a permanent basis. Such appointments are made by the Garda Commissioner and are outside my remit. I have raised my concern and I hope this appointment could be filled in the near future rather than the long term. In the meantime, I have appointed Inspector Dermot O'Connor as the Acting District Officer for the Bruff Garda District and he will be only too willing to deal with any policing matters you may have pending the appointment of a full-time District Officer.

The allocation of additional Garda Resources to the Bruff District is a matter that is kept firmly under review and I expect to see some shift in that regard in the near future with the allocation of additional resources following on from the allocation of new Probationer Gardai in the Limerick Division in the near future.
