Disposal of Land at Main Street, Knockaderry, County Limerick.

It is intended that the following proposed Disposal of Land, which includes the former Council Library at Knockaderry, will be included on the Agenda for the March Council Meeting:

Dispose of 0.0377 Hectares at Main Street, Knockaderry to Knockaderry Clouncagh Resource Centre Limerick CLG.


The Library had ceased to function as a lending Library in the mid 1970's and was often closed for long periods of time. In 1981 the Library was reopened under the direction of Knockaderry Clouncagh Community Council. During the 1990's an area of land to the rear of the Library was purchased by the Community Council and this is where the Resource Centre is now built. Both buildings are linked and provide a venue for a large number of community events. The Library building was extensively refurbished in 2006 by the local community.

Knockaderry Clouncagh Resource Centre Limerick CLG has now requested the Council to transfer title to them.

The land and building in question is not required by the Council for any of its functions.
