I will ask at the next Meeting for an update on unfinished upgrade on street lighting in Hospital, particularly in relation to estates

Reply:

There was a total of 5 infill lights required as part of the upgrade to the town of Hospital on the main public network. These lights required connections from E.S.B.

Airtricity currently have the lights installed on the timber poles and we are awaiting E.S.B to make the final connections. Airtricity said they are confident the 5 lights will be operating before the end of April 2018

There is no funding available at present for the upgrading of estates to LED lighting.
