

I love music and have played a small organ, tin whistle and getar but I most well known for my singing which I am very good at. I was in various folk groups, choir's and prayer groups which greatly improved my singing ability and improved my musical and acting abilities. I have ran in many marathons including the woman's mini marathon. I was part of Irish Blind Sports and Irish Blind Golf and even appeared on RTE News on a golf tournament. I am excellent at Art and some of my

paintings are on display in Louth County Hospital. I have set up a large amount of chat groups plus web sites in order to help, support, provide information for as many people as possible with health issues, disabilities, the elderly, children, the disadvantaged, foreign nationals and people who suffered abuse and false imprisonment of all kinds also to provide historic background to this kind of abuse here in Ireland and abroad. I have not been able to complete all of these yet for many reasons but hope to do so in the future.

I would like as many counsellors and councils as possible to put me forward for election as President of Ireland as I believe I have all the necessary skills, experience talents to enable me to discharge all aspects of the role of president of Ireland. I would become an ambassador for Ireland especially Athlone and the Midlands.
