**Chairperson's Report for the Community, Leisure and Emergency Services
Strategic Policy Committee (SPC) Meeting of the 16th April 2018.**

Summary Report/Main Issues:

Presentations regarding four separate areas were delivered to the SPC members. The first was a review for members on the Draft Integration Plan 2017-2021. The remaining three items were the National Physical Activity Plan, Get Ireland Walking and Phase 1 of the Play Strategy for Limerick City and County Council and were covered in one presentation.

Item 1: Consideration of Draft Integration Plan 2017 - 2021

Eugene Quinn of the Integration Working Group gave a presentation to members in support of the Draft Integration Plan which was before the members for ratification. His presentation was followed by a Questions and Answers session. On completion of the Q & A session, the members voted unanimously to recommend the Draft Integration Strategy be adopted by the full Council at their next meeting.

Item 2: Presentation on National Physical Activity Plan, Get Ireland Walking, Phase 1 of Limerick City & County Councils Play Strategy.

The members received a presentation from Mo Foley Walsh, Healthy Limerick Co-Ordinator, updating them on three linked strategies, Get Ireland Walking, National Physical Activity Plan and Councils Play Strategy. The full presentation was followed by a Q & A session.

RECOMMENDATION:- It is recommended by the SPC members that Limerick City and County Council adopt the Draft Integration Strategy for Limerick City & County, as presented.
