The location of this work alongside the River Shannon is in a Special Area of Conservation and an Appropriate Assessment was required and has just been completed.

Limerick City and County Council is inviting tenders for this work on Monday, 28th May, 2018. The tender period will be 2 weeks approx. The work associated with the building of the wall should commence during July 2018 and the contract period is envisaged to be up to 3 weeks.



REPLY:

The implementation of a Choice-based Letting system is currently being examined with a view to activation in Q4 2018. A Choice-based letting system may operate initially on a pilot basis targeting low demand areas to measure its effectiveness. A workshop for Elected Members to discuss the objectives and procedures will take place prior to implementation.
