I will ask at the next Meeting for an update on the current status of the Limerick Northern Distributor Road Phase 2, and a projected timeline for planning and works to begin.

### Reply

Limerick City and County Council working with Clare County Council, DTTAS and The Project Design Team are currently proceeding with various studies, design work and environmental assessments on the LNDR scheme. Funding was provided in 2018 by DTTAS to continue advancing this important road scheme. The timelines for this scheme are dependent on the completion of Design Work and Environmental Assessments by the Design Team which must be submitted to DTTAS for approval and consent to submit the scheme to An Bord Pleanála. At this time, it is expected that it will be at least late 2019 before the scheme is ready to submit to ABP. We will advise the Council further as the project progresses.
