

I refer to the above and your correspondence dated the 16th August, 2018.


The District Traffic Unit and local Gardai to Adare, Garda P. Buckley and Garda R. Hayes were tasked with monitoring this matter.

Several speed checks at this location was conducted and no detections were reported.

Local Garda, Garda Patrick Buckley has described this road as poor with a series of bad bends and narrow in areas and drivers have to adapt their driving accordingly and due to this there would be little opportunity for driver to speed excessively. This road is currently assigned a speed limit of 80kmph. Garda Buckley reported these complaints maybe resolved if the speed limit was amended on this section of road or the roadway improved.

Gardai and District Traffic personal are aware of this complaint and will report any new developments in course.
