During 2018, 11 spot fines were issued in the District. The total number of spot fines issued in the City / County in 2018 was 448.



I will ask at the next Meeting for an update on my motion that was passed in relation to establishing a pedestrian bridge along the Christopher Lynch bridge in Rathkeale.

REPLY:

The installation of a pedestrian footbridge, adjacent to the exiting roadbridge (Christopher Lynch Bridge) can be considered, however, no funding has been identified or provided for this in the current capital plan.

Consideration could be given by the Municipal Council of Adare-Rathkeale to assigning a portion of the 2019 General Municipal Allocation budget for the District to look at a feasibility study for this bridge. If the study concludes that the provision of a bridge is feasible, then an application for funding could be made under the Town and Village Renewal Scheme, administered by the Department of Rural and Community Development, or the Rural Regeneration and Development Fund (RRDF), to provide the Bridge.
