
I will ask at the next meeting "When will Phase 2 of the Urban Village Renewal Scheme for Patrickswell commence and confirmation that the funding that was ring-fenced for same is still in place."

Reply

Extensive works have been undertaken in upgrading the public realm of Patrickswell in recent years utilising a combination of Hinterland Scheme, Town and Village Renewal Scheme, Development Contribution Scheme funding, and the Council's own revenue resources, totalling more than €738,000.

The total allocation received from the Town and Village Renewal Scheme was recouped under Phase 1 of the scheme, along with all the other sources outlined above.

The Council will continue its efforts to source funding for Phase 2 of the scheme, which cannot proceed until such time as the funding is identified and secured.

I will ask at the next meeting for an update on schedule for implementation of 30 kph traffic calming in housing estates.

REPLY:

The implementation of 30kph speed limits in housing estates is included in the overall speed limit review for Limerick. In addition to proposals to introduce 30kph speed limits in housing estates, there are also proposed changes to existing speed limits on National, regional and other Local Roads. There are still outstanding issues with respect to proposed changes on some National roads and a meeting will be held with TII shortly to discuss these. Following this, it is expected that the final draft schedules for all speed limits will be submitted to the Council for review and adoption.


