# REPLY:

Snow's Cross, Ballingarry is a Rural Junction of Regional Road R520 Newcastle West Road & R519 Ballingarry Road. There is no existing lighting near this location. It is policy not to install lighting in isolated rural locations. There has been no recorded accidents at this location according to the Road Safety Authority collision statistics for 2005-2015. A scheme of the nature requested could cost in the region of €100,000. There is no capital budget to available to install new public lighting schemes.
