
*That Wicklow County Council agree that the evidence of emergency is overwhelming from IPCC on Climate [3] and from WWF LPR on Biodiversity [4].*

I wish to inform you that at the April meeting of the Manorhamilton Municipal District, the Members unanimously passed the following resolution:

“That Leitrim County Council to write to the Minister for Health Simon Harris TD and the Minister for Agriculture Michael Creed to call for a ban on the use of Glyphosate (Roundup) as a desiccant on our nations crops.

Roundup is a weed killer and was never intended to be used as a desiccant on oats, wheat, barley or any other crop prior to harvest, this practice has gone on for over 40 years. Scientific evidence has linked Glyphosate to various types of cancers and traces of Glyphosate are being found in bread and cereals and in drinking water.”



Under the Health Act 2004, the Health Service Executive (HSE) is required to manage and deliver, or arrange to be delivered on its behalf, health and personal social services. Section 6 of the HSE Governance Act 2013 bars the Minister for Health from directing the HSE to provide a treatment or a personal service to any individual or to confer eligibility on any individual.

As the information requested by you comes under the remit of the Health Service Executive your correspondence has been sent to the Parliamentary Affairs Division of the HSE who will arrange for a reply to issue to you directly.

Under the Health Act 2004, the Health Service Executive (HSE) is required to manage and deliver, or arrange to be delivered on its behalf, health and personal social services. Section 6 of the HSE Governance Act 2013 bars the Minister for Health from directing the HSE to provide a treatment or a personal service to any individual or to confer eligibility on any individual.

As the information requested by you comes under the remit of the Health Service Executive your correspondence has been sent to the Parliamentary Affairs Division of the HSE who will arrange for a reply to issue to you directly.

I refer to your representation on behalf of the above named and I wish to advise you of the following:






