

SAMPLE NEWSPAPER NOTICE FOR SIGNIFICANT FURTHER INFORMATION/REVISED PLANS

PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS 2001 - 2018

In accordance with Article 35 (1) of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001 - 2018 it will be necessary for you to erect or fix a site notice on the land or structure to which the further information relates and to re-advertise your proposal in a suitable newspaper circulating in the area (not an evening paper). You are required to submit the relevant page of the newspaper or a copy of relevant page, including the date and title of the newspaper.

The heading in the newspaper must state ‘**Limerick City & County Council**’ and be marked ‘**Significant Further Information**’ or ‘**Revised Plans**’.

The advertisement must state:

- I. The name of the applicant,
- II. The street name, location, townland or postal address of the land structure to which the application relates (as may be appropriate),
- III. The reference number of the application on the register,
- IV. Significant further information or revised plans, as appropriate, in relation to the application has or have been furnished to the Planning Authority and is or are available for inspection or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at the offices of the Authority during its public opening hours, and a submission or observation in relation to the further information or revised plans may be made in writing to the Planning Authority on payment of the prescribed fee, **not later than 2 weeks after the receipt of the newspaper notice and site notice by the Planning Authority**, or in the case of a planning application accompanied by an Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR), within 5 weeks of receipt of such notices by the Planning Authority.
