


GREAT SOUTHERN GREENWAY LIMERICK

OVERVIEW

BACKGROUND

- Licence put in place between CIE and Limerick City & County Council
- Limerick City & County Council assume responsibility for the then Great Southern Trail – November 2015

GOAL

- To develop a top class Greenway to National standard.



OVERVIEW

Devon Road
"Great South Bay"
This station, operated from 20th Dec 1900 to 1963, is the
final Limerick to Tralee passenger train location
which has now also long since closed.

PLANNING STAGE

- 2017 - Part VIII Granted Enhancement works on GSGL
- 2018 - Part VIII Granted. Incorporation of the Old Barnagh Rail Tunnel to the Greenway.



OVERVIEW

IMPLEMENTATION

- Phase I: Enhancement Works on Greenway.
Completed 2017
Cost : €476,500
- Phase II: Incorporation of Old Barnagh Railway Tunnel to the Greenway.
Due for completion Sept. 2019
Cost : €744,494
- Phase III: Surface Upgrade, Barnagh Works- Phase II and other improvement works.
Due for completion March 2020



FUNDING TO DATE

- RRDF. €2.74 Million
- Development Fund €100,000
- Council Rural Development Fund €400,000
- Hinterland Fund €500,000



FUNDING CURRENTLY APPLIED FOR.

- Rural Regeneration Development Fund:
- An application has been submitted to the Rural Regeneration Development Fund for additional funding on the Great Southern Greenway Limerick. This will comprise of a funding request to complete resurfacing programme and reconnecting Barnagh viewing carpark to the existing Greenway
- Total Estimated Cost : €3,676,000
- RRDF: €2,757,000
- Match Funding LC&CC €919,000



AUTOMATIC COUNTERS MONTHLY DATA JUNE 2019




