Dear Mr Clune,

Thank you for your letter of invitation (attached) to the meeting of the Metropolitan District of Limerick on 21 October 2019.

Unfortunately, I do not have anyone available to attend the meeting on Monday October 21st.

I understand that the previous meeting of the Metropolitan District on 7 October addressed the recent granting of a licence by the Environmental Protection Agency to Irish Cement Ltd to burn alternative fuels at its facility at Mungret. Therefore I am making the presumption that the Members may have questions relating to this licence.

The HSE made a number of submissions to the licensing process in relation to the burning of alternative fuels at Irish Cement in Mungret, all of which are in the public domain and available on the EPA website. The HSE submission included advice obtained from Centre for Radiation, Chemical and Environmental Hazards (CRCE) which is part of Public Health England and is based in Cardiff.

It would be very helpful if you could set out the specific questions and issues that you feel could be addressed by the HSE at this stage at a meeting of the Metropolitan District of Limerick. It would be best if these questions were sent to my Department please, well in advance of any future proposed meeting (I suggest a minimum of 10 working days in advance please), to ensure that those questions are appropriate for the HSE or if some questions are more appropriate for the EPA (or other Agency), they can be redirected.


