An invitation letter was received to attend the **TRAINART Kick-off meeting** to be held in **Ancona (IT) on 29 and 30 of October 2019**. Limerick City and County Council are an associate partner in this Creative Europe funded project that aims to **build new skills for innovative business models in the performing arts sector**.

In this project, Culture and Creative Industries (CCI's) are asked to reflect about their business models in order to find out their own idiosyncrasies, needs, opportunities, and constraints to improve their economic performance. Thus, TRAINART will focus on two particular aspects of the CCIs: (i) the introduction of innovative services in partners performing art portfolios (i.e. live performances in non-conventional contexts) and (ii) innovative business ideas for the management of cultural spaces (i.e. theatres). Limerick City and County Council will be associate partner on the project.
