I will move at the next meeting that a safety barrier and footpath be put in place between the brick lodge and the roundabout on the N69 at Clarina Village as there already has been numerous fatalities at this location over the years.

REPLY:

A footway currently exists between Clarina roundabout and the Brick Lodge. A safety barrier cannot be installed at present as there is insufficient width available to allow the barrier to be installed. Service Operations – Central Services are currently preparing a preliminary design to improve the existing footway arrangements for pedestrians on this section of the N69. The improvements proposed include setting back the existing footway from the N69 carriageway and providing a greater width of separation between the pedestrians and vehicles. This proposal would require land acquisition. If agreement can be reached with the affected landowners, a feasibility report will be prepared for submission to Transport Infrastructure Ireland for approval and funding.
