I will move at the next Meeting that a pedestrian crossing be provided at the church in Templeglantine.

REPLY:

The original design prepared by the Mid West National Road Design Office for the Templeglantine traffic calming scheme proposed an uncontrolled pedestrian crossing at the Church. During the public consultation phase of the planning for this scheme, it was requested and agreed locally that a more suitable location for the crossing was closer to the national school. The scheme proceeded to construction and a crossing was constructed at the agreed location.

It should be noted that Limerick City and County Council has consulted with TII on the provision of a pedestrian crossing at the Church. TII have no objection in principle with having a crossing the church, but it would require that the existing crossing be removed as having two crossings in close proximity on the national road could create a traffic hazard. It should also be noted that TII would not fund such an alteration.
