Joint Policing Strategy

- Joint Policing Committee Guidelines (amended August 2014)
- ▶ JPC Strategy (5 year 2017-2021)
 - Linked to relevant objectives in the Local Economic and Community Plan (LECP) 2016-2021
 - (Included in Workshop Materials Note)
- ▶ JPC Annual Work Plans
 - Linked to LECP + objectives from the Garda Annual Policing Plans for the local area
 - Other elements of local authority or Garda strategies (accommodation, crime prevention, Drugs Task Force Plans, public safety including road safety, emergency planning etc.)

JPC Strategy (CONTD)

- Strategy & Annual Plan required to fit with functions of JPCs
 - a) Keep under review: crime patterns, disorder & factors associated with them (e.g., misuse of drugs, alcohol)
 - Advise LA and AGS on how they can best deal with issues: Safety & quality of life, prevent crime, disorder, anti-social behaviour
 - c) Arrange & host annual public meeting on matters affecting policing Engage with stakeholders & communication.

Strategic Themes

Four Strategic Themes identified in JPC Plan 2017 -2021

- STI Enhancing Governance and Communication
- ST 2: Enhancing the role of local communities in crime prevention & response
- ST 3:Working with communities to improve cohesion, inclusion & reduce anti-social behaviour
- ST 4: Improving traffic flows & road safety.
- Proposed that each of the 2018 meetings should focus on a particular Theme as outlined above.

Strategic Themes (contd)

- Today's Theme is ST1 Enhancing Governance and Communication.
- Proposal is that for each meeting presentations / case studies will be brought forward for consideration by the members to assist gaining a greater understanding of the issues and the actions required by the JPC.
- Strategic issues only will come to JPC Committee.
- Operational issues will be brought to the Metropolitan / Municipal District Sub – Committees where the local Garda Superintendent will be in attendance.

ST1 Enhancing Governance and Communication

- Group of the JPC to monitor implementation of the JPC Strategy and Annual Work Plans.
- 2. Establish geographic subcommittees to match the divisions of the Metropolitan and Municipal Districts of the Council.
- 3. Publish the JPC Strategy 2017-2021

- Proposed that this role be carried out by Steering Group – Chairman of JPC, Chief Superintendent, Chief Executive of LCCC.
- Sub- Committees in place.

ST1 Enhancing Governance and Communication

- Prepare JPC Annual Work Plans.
- Develop and Implement Communications Strategy for the JPC.
- Agree indicators set on recorded offences of crime and format for presentation of local crime data.

- Plan for 2017 in place.
 - Prepare Plan for 2018.

ST1 Enhancing Governance and Communication (contd)

Identify issues of local concern to give insights to crime and factors associated with it.

- Develop data exchange and data sharing approach protocols between the key stakeholders
- Socio-economic factors, experiences of communities and sections of the population with stronger prevalence of crime etc.

communities in crime prevention & response

This will be the Theme for JPC meeting number 2.

Potential items to include:

- Presentation on CCTV and developments in relation to the roll out of the schemes in Limerick.
- Overview of Text Alert / Neighbourhood Watch and how to promote community crime prevention.
- Case study on groups at high risk or more vulnerable to crime.
- Purple Flag benefits etc.
- Inter-agency co-operation what's happening.
- Collaboration with other partners on key issues where to.



ST 3: Working with communities to improve cohesion, inclusion & reduce anti-social behaviour

- 1. This will be the Theme for meeting number 3.
- 2. Agenda to be developed based on Strategy.

ST 4: Improving traffic flows & road safety

- This will be the theme for meeting number 4.
- This meeting will also be the annual "Public meeting" and will be held at location outside of MQ.
- Agenda to be developed based on Strategic Plan
