Re: Proposed Amendment to Standing Orders for Limerick City and County Council Standing Orders

A Chomhairleoir, a chara,

It is proposed that Standing Order No. 5 of the Standing Orders for Limerick City and County Council be amended to change the process for selecting alternative venues to allow for future Meetings to be held away from the Council Chamber, if required.

Standing Order No 5. Currently reads:

In so far as practicable the place for holding Meetings of the Council shall be in the Council Chamber, Dooradoyle and Meetings shall normally be held there. The Council may from time to time, by Resolution, appoint an alternative location for a particular Meeting.

The following amendment is proposed for Standing Order No 5.:

Meetings shall normally take place at the Council's principal offices unless another venue within the administrative area is agreed with the Mayor of the City and County of Limerick.

In accordance with Paragraph 16 of Schedule 10 of the Local Government Act, 2001 (as amended), a resolution of the Council is required to amend Standing Orders and at least one-half of the total number of Members of the Council would be required to vote in favour of the amendment.
