REPLY:

Thank you for your email regarding Newcastle West Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade.

The Upgrade of the Newcastle West WWTP is included on the Irish Water Investment Plan. It is currently at the earliest Feasibility Study stage. Engineering consultants will shortly be appointed to undertake this feasibility study after which a full project scope will be determined. At this early stage it is scheduled that the Works will be undertaken in the period 2024 to 2026. It is not possible to fast track projects such as this given the current Investment Plan priorities and funding availability.


