Description

Overall design capacity of the wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) in population equivalents (PE) today (the date at the top of this table).

Overall design capacity of the WWTP in population equivalents (PE) upon completion of a relevant project delivering additional capacity. Note that 'WWDL' or 'UWW' following the capacity value indicates that the upgraded WWTP will have capability to achieve the full Waste Water Discharge Licence (WWDL) emission limit values (ELVs) in the former case, or at least the Urban Waste Water (UWW) Treatment Directive parametric values in the latter case.



The Planning Authority served an Enforcement Notice for the erection of railings, gateway, entrance and the subsequent fencing/enclosure of land at Main Street, Bruree. As this Enforcement Notice was not complied with, this matter was referred for legal action which is ongoing currently.

In relation to the existing bridge and road over it, this is in CIE ownership and was never a public road.
