8. Notice of Motion submitted by Councillor S. Keary

I will move at the next Meeting, given the current placement of Level 5 restrictions on the country due to the Coronavirus pandemic and the stated position of the Government that there be no non-essential travel to work or meetings, that Limerick City and County Council call upon the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage, Mr. Darragh O'Brien, T.D., to allow the current Development Plans for Limerick, including the Limerick County Development Plan, to be extended again for a further 18 months; furthermore, I call upon the Chief Executive of Limerick City and County Council to engage immediately with the Secretary General of the Department of Housing and his officials to discuss the necessary provisions to allow the Development Plans to be extended.
