Limerick City and County Council has confirmed that work on the €9.1m revitalisation of O'Connell Street will proceed following a review of critical transport infrastructure projects in Limerick.

On site works had been due to start last January but had been halted due to Level 5 restrictions. Further to consultation at government departmental level and with project funders, Limerick City and County Council has determined that it is now appropriate to proceed with the works.

Limerick City and County Council awarded ShareRidge Limited the contract for the Limerick O'Connell Street Revitalisation Project -Phase One and look forward to working with the various stakeholders and the people of Limerick in the weeks and months ahead.

ShareRidge Limited have already carried out Property Condition Surveys on the externals of all of the buildings located adjacent to the works.

We have contacted all premises with basements and where permitted scheduled basement surveys to be completed **Monday 8th** and **Tuesday 9th March**

On **Thursday 11th March** we will be photographing the existing street and we will carry this out each month for the duration of the job to show the "before and after" and to record the progress.

The first phase of the project will commence on Thomas Street, between Little William Street and O'Connell Street. We will be removing all street paving and furniture and installing new communications and power ducting while replacing some existing water main connections.

Over the past number of months, we have been working hard behind the scenes to ensure that this project is delivered in as smooth a manner as possible.

- In conjunction with Limerick City and County Council we have developed a traffic management plan to provide alternative routes for non-city destination traffic around the city peripheral road networks. - ShareRidge have also been developing plans to ensure the Health and Safety of both the general public and our construction workers. We have been planning our construction methods to minimise any disruption to stakeholders, residents and local businesses, while ensuring access and egress is maintained to premises at all times.
- Full and detailed consideration has been given to relevant environmental issues and waste management.
- Over the last few weeks, we have been making every effort to ensure that traders who will be affected by and benefit from this project have been contacted and communicated with.
 - Almost 500 information letters have been handed out to businesses and residents over the past four weeks.
 - Over 100 phone calls and almost 900 emails have been sent to stakeholders to date.
 - We will be in contact businesses and premises on Thomas Street and O'Connell Street between William Street and Thomas Street to gather information in regard to deliveries and refuse collections.
