**Notice of Motion submitted by Councillor S. Novak Uí Chonchúir (referred from Metro Meeting)**

I will move at the next Meeting of the Metropolitan District of Limerick that Limerick City and County Council develop and deliver a communication/education campaign about safe and appropriate parking practices, with a focus on the dangers of parking on footpaths, cycle lanes and bus stops.

**Reply:**

Parking on footpaths, cycle lanes and bus stops is a recurring issue for Limerick City and County Council. While Limerick City and County Council have a role, in conjunction with An Garda Síochána, in enforcing by-law regulations, it is recognised that the problem persists and an education and training program, focusing on safe parking practices, would indeed serve a useful purpose. If the Notice of Motion is agreed, Limerick City and County Council will contact the Road Safety Authority, who are the national body for road safety educational campaigns to request that such a programme be developed in conjunction with An Garda Síochána. Limerick City and County Council will reflect any such campaign across its Marketing and Communication channels.
