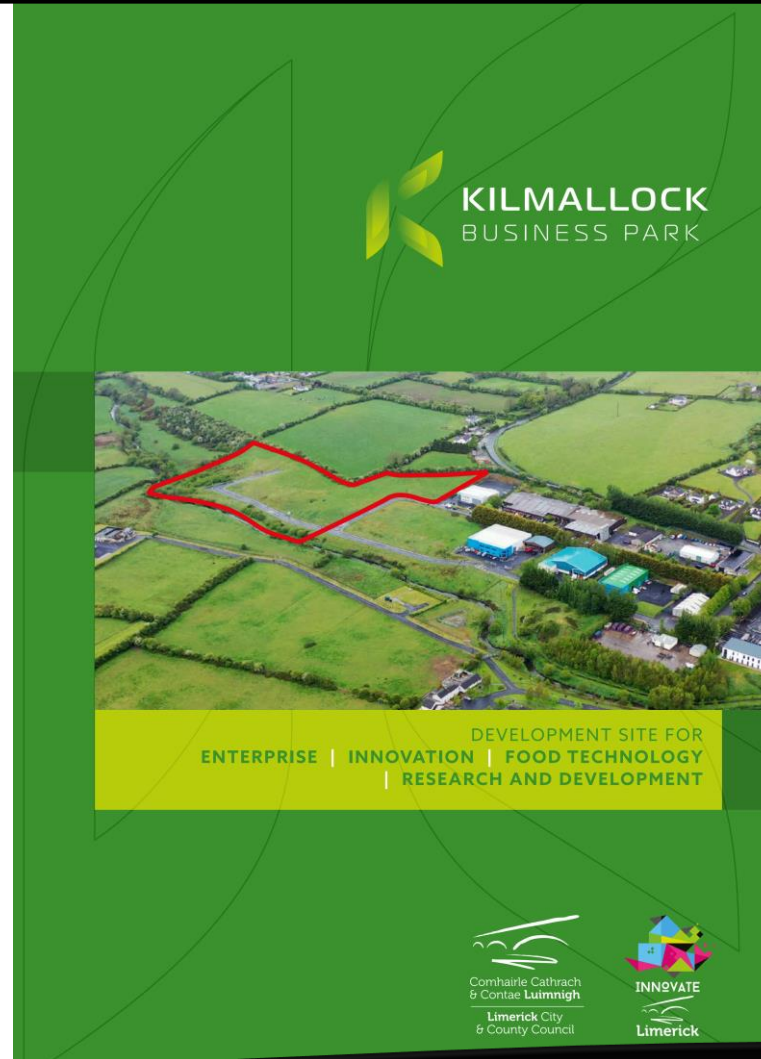




Proposed Development at Bruree
